Overall I think this is an excellent article and positively contributes to social work knowledge. There a few things in need of attention before I could recommend full acceptance: 1. I recommend including a couple of statements either in the abstract or introduction to connect the relevance of the research to social work practice. 2. There is a spelling error in the Introduction section: "Gevre" - should be Greve. 3. On page 5 in Methodolgy section - recommend rewording "deprived families" to person first language as this sounds derogatory. Additionally, what are they allegedly deprived of? 4. On page 6 where the contents of the PLAYBAG are described: a. there is either something missing or comma errors. b. recommend clarifying what a "torch" is. I assume it is a flashlight, but in the U.S. a torch involves fire, so I am hopefully assuming that is not what is being referred to. Once these revisions are attended to, I would recommend this article for the journal.
