Regarding the structure of the abstract:

- Provide a brief introduction to the topic under investigation.
- Explain the significance of the topic within the field.
- Identify the research gap.
- State the research question(s) or aim(s).
- Outline the research methods and approach.
- Convey the key message.
- Summarize the key findings.
- Explain the contribution of the findings and key message to the field(s).

From my understanding of writing a research article, the structure typically includes:

1. Abstract: No need intext references
2. Introduction: Provides an overview of the article or research project, including its objectives.
3. Literature Review: Reviews relevant articles and concepts related to the research.
4. Methodology: Describes the research methods employed.
5. Results
6. Discussion

The current article does not adhere to the structure expected of a research article.
