The author does not have consent from an individual (his former wife) to provide considerable identifying information about her. Some of it is less than positive. I have served on the American Psychological Association Ethics committee and publishing any research that does not assure the anonymity of all subjects requires the consent of those subjects to be involved in the study or publication of any information that would identify them.

This statement by the author on page 5 “Regardless, privacy considerations have been observed. Author One and his former spouse, who have been apart for approximately ten years, do not share a last name.” is woefully inadequate. To think that not sharing a last name protects the privacy of his former spouse, who he refers to in detail multiple times, is simply false.
