I don't see much value added by this manuscript in its current condition. Few observations are listed below:

- 1. Heavy repetition of sentences
- 2. No properly established methodology for factor analysis
- 3. No clear explanation of development of scale, its reliability and validity.
- 4. Socioeconomic factors were used just to show distribution of patients, but not to show differences in fear factor by those categories.
- 5. No mention of whether IRB was done for this research.
- 6. No clarity of location of this study.
- 7. Discussion and conclusions are not based on the findings
- 8. The study also claims that many respondents are not married, hence they do not have a support system (e.g. from spouses). It seems odd to me.
- 9. Poor writing and establishment of hypothesis.
