Under the workforce development and management intro section, the information here is appropriate, but I think it is skewed only toward healthcare workers. I would love to see this section expanded to include other health categories such as use of AI in public health jobs (grant funded work, etc.).

I feel like there are a lot of different format utilized in this manuscript (bullets and numbers). I suspect this will be aligned in the publishing process, but want to call attention to it. Seems there's multiple types of fonts used throughout as well. Again, likely to be addressed later, but it is distracting to the reader.

The most recent reference used is from 2022. I would expect a topic so emerging to utilize more recent publications as I would expect this to be an ever-changing landscape.

I think overall, the manuscript is okay. I think some additional work needs to be done to expand the section above that I noted, to be more inclusive of the health work force. I also think the references should be more recent, given the topic. Lastly, I think the formatting of the manuscript needs to be aligned and consistent before publication.
