The manuscript requires a thorough restructuring to enhance its overall clarity and organization. This restructuring will not only align it with the journal's requirements but also make it more readable and engaging. To align with the journal's requirements, the abstract should be expanded significantly. Furthermore, it is essential to incorporate a Literature Review and a section discussing implications for practice. The inclusion of additional references is also necessary, as certain paragraphs currently contain few citations aside from those listed at the end. By integrating more references, the depth and breadth of your research will be more effectively emphasized.

The article would significantly benefit from the inclusion of additional references drawn from the relevant academic literature. Furthermore, it is advisable to update some existing references to reflect current research findings. Emphasizing studies published within the last decade would enhance the article's relevance and complement foundational works with more recent publications. This approach, which ensures a balanced representation of both seminal and contemporary contributions to the field, will make the article comprehensive and well-rounded.

This article possesses significant potential; however, it requires thorough revision and subsequent resubmission.
