

**Manuscript Title: Movement inequities:**

How Race, Class, and Gender Shape Access and Participation in Sport and Rehabilitation

**Reviewer's Comments: Is the manuscript important for the scientific community? (Few sentences)**

This manuscript is appropriate for the scientific community. However, there are significant errors in the delivery of results (lacking) and there are several grammatical errors that need to be cleaned up and/or clarified. Once these are addressed, the manuscript is likely a good fit for publication.

**Strengths:**

1. **Clear Research Objective:** Objective is clear, but results are lacking clarity.
2. **Methodological Rigor:** Author needs to address the methods section. Not clear.
3. **Clinical Relevance:** This content is relevant to the field of study, but lacking evidence of data collection and outcomes that support the intent of the study.
4. **Comprehensive Literature Review:** Literature review is sufficient.
5. **Well-Organized Structure:** The methodology is lacking detail and needs to be addressed.

**Area of improvement:**

1. **Title:** None
2. **Abstract:** Corrections are needed. See comments on document.
3. **Introduction:** Introduction is clear, but not sure where it ends.
4. **Methodology Clarity:** This needs to be addressed. There is no clear indication of what the methodology is for this paper.
5. **Figures:** No figures provided. Should be added.
6. **Tables and Study Data Integration:**
7. **Discussion:** Lacking detail on where the discussion begins and where the introduction ends.
8. **Limitation:** Not addressed.
9. **Conclusion:** Lacking detail of what results were actually analyzed in this study.
10. **References:** Need to fix multiple references. Mostly grammatical errors.

**Minor Suggestions:**

1. **Clarity & Conciseness**

Need to clarify methodology and analysis of data. What is being analyzed and how are results being addressed (methodology is not clear).

## **2. Minor Typographical & Formatting Issues**

Correct all grammatical errors highlighted (see comments on document). There are a lot of errors to address.

### **Recommendations for Publication:**

To start, correct all grammatical errors and address the methodology section.
