

Reviewer's comment:-

1. I am not sure it adds much new to the science. It reads like a textbook or course assignment rather than a scientific contribution. I think more clear implications for future research and practice would be essential.
2. I am not sure the subtitle is apt. is this really a foundation for practice? Or a summary for practice?
3. I think so. The evidence presented in the paper is not as 'overwhelming' as it should be. There is much in the literature that is not included. The inclusion of domestic and international content is too broad for one paper.
4. The early "social work contributions..." section seems forced and out of place. Maybe move it to just before the "Implications for..." section and make those two parts build on one another.
5. Given the title, the inclusion of 'classic' or foundational texts from history is appropriate. However, as a foundation for contemporary practice, more up-to-date sources are needed and the 'implications' section should be updated with newer sources.
