1. The manuscript addresses a critical gap in homelessness and housing research by synthesizing qualitative lived experiences rather than focusing solely on quantitative outcomes. the title is clear and fits the subject matter.
2. Overall the English is clear and professional. I found some minor issues, including typographical errors (e.g., “PERMNANENT HOUSING” header) and occasional repetitiveness across sections that could be streamlined.
3. References are relevant and include recent sources (2018–2022).

Suggestions:

- Add more recent literature on Housing First and supportive housing post-2022.
 - Include disability and intersectionality-focused housing studies to broaden scope.
4. **This manuscript makes a meaningful contribution to the scientific community by centering the lived experiences of individuals transitioning from homelessness to permanent housing.
